Updates on concerns voiced at the

Annual Meeting:

- Speed Bumps The Village of Milford Village Manager will not allow speed bumps to be installed because of road maintenance concerns (snowplows, cracking, etc.).
- Speeding through the neighborhood The Neighborhood Watch program is in effect. Please report any speeding or reckless drivers directly to the Milford Police. Also, the Board is researching signs to caution drivers of Children at Play for the Mill Street and Dorchester entrances.
- **Streetside Parking** Since our neighborhood is very hilly and curvy, please consider safety and visibility when choosing where to park your car. Whenever possible, please park your cars and your visitor's cars in the driveway.
- Recreation on "the hill"- Please remember that motorized vehicles (ATV's, dirt bikes, etc.) and bikes are not allowed on the hill due to increased liability and safety concerns.
- Pets Please be considerate of not allowing your dog to bark outside for excessive periods of time and remember to pick up your pet waste on neighborhood walks.
- "Cutting through" the yards Unless you or your family have received permission from the home owners, please do not cut across lawns. This presents concerns with privacy and pets for your neighbors.
